MEMBERSHIP EXPLAINED

The annual membership fee of \$80.00 primarily covers the club/committee insurance and administration costs. An additional **one-off fee** of \$60.00 is for the machinery induction. Both fees are payable when joining the Guild.

The induction can be booked with the workshop foreman on confirmation of your membership. It will generally include how to use 3/5 machines and safety procedures.

We will also do a clubhouse orientation that will include; walkaround of the clubhouses, first aid and fire plan information, funding and cleaning maintenance etc.

The membership kit includes; [Handbook Guild](#), [Code of Conduct](#) and [Constitution](#)

The Annual Membership of \$80^ is payable before the 1 July of each year. Any member renewing membership after this date will be classed as a non-financial member and therefore will not be able to use the Guild facilities until membership is paid in full as they will not be covered by insurance.

Fees are calculated on a quarterly pro rata arrangement for persons joining during a started term of membership. **(Example:** New membership application to join made in April will only be required to pay ¼ of the fees = \$20 + Joining fee} ^ Aged Pensioners qualify for a \$5 reduction in the annual membership fee.

Payment Methods:

In Person: Drop in to the Guild and return your completed form with your cheque or payment to the duty person
EFT: Pay by bank deposit by listing your name as reference to: **BSB 034 664 - Account 117258**

The Committee may at its discretion, accept or reject any application for membership. The decision will be solely at the discretion of the Committee and is final.

Please note: Once membership is confirmed a machine induction and clubhouse induction can be organised
